ALL EVENTS scheduled throughout this year are free of charge and conducted by yours truly, "Uncle Jack" Christensen. I'm giving three walking tours and one indoor lecture during the first week of every month, which is a great reduction from the number of walks and talks I've presented once a month in former years. I started conducting excursions as a part time venture way back in 1962 with a single offering, The Honolulu Church & Temple Tour, and by now I've become The Aloha State's **oldest and only** individual personally escorting over **twenty** different outings on five islands.

MY MONTHLY PRESENTATIONS for the general public are also available privately for individuals and couples and small groups unable to attend the regular activities. Descriptions of my other original outings are shown on pages 16-19, including all my favorite scenic and historic sites. Some single day fly-drive visits to neighbor islands feature special places that are ideal for quick trips.

JUST FOR THE RECORD: My full name is Jack Shields Christensen and I was born in Wisconsin. I grew up in Southern California and came to Honolulu in 1956, enrolling at the University Of Hawai'i as a sophomore transfer student from San Diego State College and the University Of Alabama. I still attend one course at UH every semester, as a senior auditor, now on campus over fifty years.

AT AGE SEVENTY-ONE, I began to learn something completely new for me, practicing springboard and high platform diving with two coaches and members of the UH Precision Diving Team, and I usually train at least twice weekly. Having reached the far side of eighty years old, I've worked up to the top 10-meter level as the oldest person in the 50th State who dives off the Olympic Tower.
